

Information on Indiana Horse Trials – August 2020

DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC: We will be following the requirements and recommendations of the USEF Action Plan for competitions, and we will expect competitors to follow the requirements set for riders by the USEF/USEA. Additional protocols, restrictions and notes will be posted on our website at <http://www.indyeventers.org> as they become available.

No paper entries. All entries must be submitted through EventEntries or XEntry. Both need to be submitted electronically when entering. Your entry must be complete before arriving at show grounds.

Bedding:

- Onsite bedding is available for \$7 a bag and can be purchased at the Hoosier Horse Park Office Friday-Sunday during office hours.
- All bedding sales after office hours will go through the show.
- Pre-order bedding is available on an individual basis. Contact the park office at **812-526-6809** for more information, once you receive your stabling assignments.
- PRE-ORDERS must be received by Thursday at 4pm prior to the start of the show.
- The Hoosier Horse Park only allows wood shavings for use in the stalls. All other materials are prohibited. A \$25 clean-up fee will be issued for any stall using improper shavings.

Camping:

- You may call the Johnson County Park office to book a site prior to the show. You must call the week of the event. The deadline to call ahead will be at 4pm on Thursday the week of your show.
- After 4pm on Thursday you can check into the Hoosier Horse Park office for a campsite.
- Camping is only allowed in designated areas. Maps will be provided to you.
- All camping fees must be paid. Hoosier Horse Park staff will collect payments and unlock electric boxes for you.
- All HHP campsites are booked through the Johnson County Parks/Hoosier Horse Park. RV sites are available for \$25/night.
- Fires are not permitted outside of portable fire pits.
- Reminder no horse trailers are permitted in the JoCo Parks Campground, only in the designated HHP campground.
- No camp sites will be booked through the show office, all sites must be reserved directly with the JoCo Park office. If you are planning on arriving after office hours, please work with the park directly for your site location.

A note on GPS directions to the Hoosier Horse Park... Many GPS units will not easily find the Hoosier Horse Park. The physical address we use for the Horse Park is **7105 S. Kern Street, Nineveh, IN 46164**. However, we cannot guarantee that this will come up in your GPS unit. Due to the past nature of this property and its proximity to the military base, sometimes an Edinburgh zip code will work (46124) and sometimes the Nineveh zip code (46164) will also work. We strongly suggest you use google maps or the Hoosier Horse Park google page.
